Directions to Carlisle High School

From the south:

Follow I-81 North to the PA-465/Plainfield Exit 44. Turn left off the exit onto PA-465 N/Allen Road for half a mile. Turn right at the light onto US-11 N and follow for 1.9 miles. Turn left at the light onto N Orange Street and proceed straight through three stop signs. The school will be directly ahead at the third stop sign.

From the north:

Follow I-81 South to the PA-641/High Street Exit 49. Turn right off the exit onto Rt. 641 West/High Street and proceed 2.7 miles to the light at N. Orange Street. Turn right onto N. Orange Street and proceed straight through three stop signs. The school will be directly ahead at the third stop sign.

About the Carlisle High School Model United Nations

The Model United Nations organization has been a part of Carlisle High School for over 30 years. The club has been under the direction of Kevin Wagner, Social Studies Department, for the past 28 years. The club has approximately 50 members that are handselected in early September through an application process composed of social studies and English skills, an essay composition, and teacher recommendations. The organization is concerned with developing diplomatic, negotiation, and debating skills within the students. Students are assigned countries to represent and must become actual ambassadors for their countries, learning their policies and governmental functions. Students are further assigned to specific committees where they must learn about select topics from their country's point of view. The highlight is a four-day international conference in March at the actual UN building in New York City bringing together over 3,000 high school students from around the world. This conference is known as the National High School Model United Nations Conference.

About Our Show

The Carlisle Christmas Craft Show is held in the Carlisle High School, 623 W. Penn Street, Carlisle, PA 17013. Admission and parking are free. The show includes over 200 crafters, concessions, and a raffle throughout the day. Ample free parking is available for all. The school is located just off Route 11 in Carlisle, PA with easy access from Interstate 81.

Merchandise

Because handcrafted items are our emphasis, the Carlisle Christmas Craft Show traditionally draws many shoppers looking for speciallymade, unique items. We are **not** a juried show but to ensure our reputation for quality, handcrafted items, which is the expectation and main attraction of this event in our community we reserve the right to refuse crafter assignments for anyone offering commercially made, franchised or resell items. We do not allow animals, fish or burning of candles, incense or potpourri at the Carlisle Christmas Craft Show.

NOTE – WiFi access is <u>not</u> available to vendors for running credit card purchases due to security issues with the district server. Vendors will need to use their own 4 or 5G network to process credit card purchases.

Crafter Spaces

We appreciate our returning crafters! We give priority to crafters from last year's Christmas Craft Show who submit timely applications.

Spaces will be assigned based on the order in which we receive applications. We then carefully review new applications and assign crafters to the space most appropriate for the merchandise you offer and your space requirements. We will consider and try to honor special requests for space location; however we cannot guarantee them.

Show Fees

There are four space options available for all crafters – 6' x 10' space (\$45) (\$60 for 2 side-by-side spaces), 10' x 10' space (\$50) and 10' x 20' space (\$60). We have also added an outdoor section (\$35). You MUST keep your displays within the space you rent. Tables can be provided at a cost of \$5.00 each on a first come, first served. We do not provide any chairs. Please bring your own extension cords if needed. There is a \$10 fee if electricity is requested.

<u>Setup &</u> <u>Breakdown</u>

Setup is available on Friday, November 1 from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. Vendors may also setup up between 6 a.m. and 9 a.m. on Saturday morning before the show on November 2. Volunteers will be available to assist in unloading your vehicle. After unloading, please move all vehicles to the assigned vendor parking area behind the school! Do not mount, tape, or nail anything on walls. Show is from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Break down time begins at 3 p.m. No exceptions to this rule; crafters who disregard this rule will not be invited back.

Concessions

The students of CHS's Culinary Arts program will serve food and drink all day from the school's café, located just beside the gymnasium. We offer coffee and sodas all day to each crafter! You will have the opportunity to purchase lunch in advance of the show and have it delivered to your space by students.

Deadlines

April 1, 2024 for returning crafters and September 1, 2024 for new crafters. We will mail notice of acceptance using the provided self-addressed, stamped envelope. If for some reason your application is not accepted your check will be returned. The sooner one applies the better!
