Prepare students for gainful employment as skilled workers or technicians in recognized, new and emerging occupations.</li> <li>2. Prepare students for enrollment in postsecondary education programs.</li> <li>3. Assist students in choosing meaningful career pathways.</li> </ol>

Definition Title 22 Sec. 4.31 SC 1801	<p>For purposes of this policy, career and technical education shall be defined as a series of planned academic and career and technical education courses articulated with one another to teach the knowledge and skills necessary to prepare students to effectively pursue recognized profitable employment.</p>

Career and technical courses of study interwoven and articulated throughout the curriculum of the school.</li> <li>2. A cooperative education program to offer students experience in private employment.</li> <li>3. Attendance at the Center for Careers and Technology and participation in a cooperative program of career development.</li> </ol>

Approve the content, organization and assessment standards of all courses stated in the Strategic Plan.</li> <li>2. Employ certified district career and technical education staff.</li> <li>3. Provide adequate facilities and equipment for maintenance of the district's program.</li> <li>4. In cooperation with the Center for Careers and Technology, establish the number of credits to be awarded toward graduation for career and technical education courses of study and for cooperative education programs.</li> </ol> <p>The Superintendent shall establish appropriate advisory committees to advise the Board, administration and staff concerning the aspects of the educational program delegated to each committee.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for developing procedures which ensure that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All district programs are operated in conformance with the current state plan for career and technical education and State Board regulations.</li> <li>2. All district teachers are properly certified for their specific career and technical teaching assignments.</li> <li>3. All approved planned instruction is carried out.</li> <li>4. Students participating in cooperative education programs are not exploited, illegally employed, or employed under conditions that fail to safeguard their health and interests.</li> <li>5. Students and parents/guardians are informed that admission to career and technical education programs is accessible to regularly enrolled students, in accordance with established criteria for admittance.</li> </ol>
